

## 2019 Stationery List

Please organise the following items by the first day of school. You, or someone in your family, may already have some of these items. We encourage recycling and the purchase of second-hand goods where appropriate. General class resource materials (including textbooks) for core subjects are provided by the school and are included in the fees.

For those new to the school, it is not necessary to bring every stationery item for each subject on the first day. It will be fine if you bring **all** of the items under the heading GENERAL. This will get you through the day. When you are familiar with your timetable, then you may bring the required items for each of your subjects.

**All subjects require a folder, loose leaf paper, pens and pencils and A4 plastic pockets.** You may choose to have a folder for each subject or have a couple of larger folders containing all subjects. It is up to you to choose and manage this for yourself. All items belonging to individual students should be labelled. Where a subject requires specific stationery items, these are listed below.
